## DISASTER ASSISTANCE

Highly trained volunteers and staff are on-call 24 hours a day to respond across the province. We ensure that the basic needs of individuals and families are met for the first 72 hours following a disaster such as a house fire or flood.

In the case of a major catastrophe like a large apartment fire, emergency evacuation or natural disaster, the Red Cross Disaster Management team responds immediately and works with our municipal and provincial partners to provide a broad range of services.

*Services may include:*

- Emergency Food
- Emergency Clothing
- Emergency Lodging
- Reception and Information
- Family Reunification
- Other services as required

As a part of our Disaster Management program, Restoring Family Links helps re-establish contact for family members who have been separated due to conflict, natural disasters, migration and other humanitarian crises around the world.
