With the required prerequisites, candidates enter into our comprehensive Youth Leader Development Program, designed to prepare them to support dynamic, learner-centered classroom environments.

YOUTH LEADER PATHWAY

Below is the pathway to becoming a certified Canadian Red Cross Youth Leader. You must successfully complete each step before advancing to the next step. Certification is valid for 3 years.

1 CHECK PREREQUISITES



Step one consists of confirming prerequisites are met: you must be certified in Standard First Aid and CPR/AED Level C and be at least 18 years old or 16-17 years old with on-site adult support.

3 TEACHING EXPERIENCE



After completing the Teaching Experience module of the online component, you will then complete a teaching experience in a real Youth First Aid classroom.
